If you don't have an established handicap, we will need your normal score. Appropriate golf attire (collared shirts and soft spikes) is required.

PLEASE NOTE - Members are required to pay the guest fee of \$75.00 for guest golfers, even if the guest does not choose to stay for dinner and prizes. This must be paid with your registration.
